RE: PROPOSED PRE-TERTIARY EDUCATION BILL

We write to indicate receipt of your letter Ref: GES/DG/245/20/214 dated 20th May, 2020 on the above subject and content of same addressed to other Sister Unions. We appreciate the attention given to some of our concerns.

It is however the considered view of the Unions that while we agree to the deletion of the Sections (29,30,31,32,33,34,35,36,37) on decentralisation as referred to in your letter, we also notes that the deletion of the affected Sections have implications on the other Sections of the Bill.

We still have some reservations with the Memorandum and the following Sections: 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,18,19,20,23,24,25,27,28,38,39,41,42,44,48,49,50,52,53 of the draft Bill.

Please refer to our earlier proposal which clarifies the position of the Unions on various Sections referred to. (Copy attached)

At our last meeting with the Parliamentary Select Committee on Education, one other issue raised was the inclusion of the Education Service in the Pre-Tertiary Education Bill. We made our position clear and unambiguous that it is inconsistent with the terms of Article 193 which emanates from Article 190 under Chapter 14 of the 1992 Constitution of the Republic of Ghana on Public Services. This position has not changed.

It is the candid view of the Unions that the entire Bill should be reviewed to take into account the implications of the deleted Sections and the concerns of the Unions.

It will be appreciated if this letter is given the needed attention and urgency it deserves.

Submitted for your attention and necessary action.
